QUIT CLAIM DEED

WARREN IRRIGATION COMPANY, a corporation, GRANTOR, of Warren, Weber County, State of Utah, hereby Quit Claims to STATE OF UTAH, acting through the WATER AND POWER BOARD, GRANTEE, of Salt Lake City, Salt Lake County, State of Utah, for the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and other good and valuable consideration, the following described tract of land and water rights in Weber County, State of Utah, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 3350 feet South and 1060 feet East from the North Quarter Corner of Section 5, Township 6 North, Range 2 West, Salt Lake Meridian, United States Survey: Running thence North 60 feet; thence West 100 feet; thence South 120 feet to South Bank; thence East along Bank 100 feet; thence North 60 feet to point of beginning.

Together with Water Right #74 as decreed in File #7487, in the District Court of the Second Judicial District, in and for Weber County, State of Utah, in the matter of Plain City Irrigation Company, a corporation, vs. Hooper Irrigation Company, a corporation, et al.

Together with an easement to the use of the irrigation system of the Grantor herein, which said irrigation system runs through parts of the following described sections, to-wit:

Secs. 5 to 8, 18, T. 6 N., R. 2 W., Secs. 9, 10, 12 to 15, 22, 23, 24, 27, T. 6 N., R. 3 W., Secs. 1, 2, 4, 19, 30, 31, T. 7 N., R. 2 W., Secs. 24, 25, 35, 36, T. 7 N., R. 3 W., of the Salt Lake Meridian, United States Survey.
