ABSTRACT OF FINDINGS AND ORDER

I, Mildred G. Snider, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the Secretary of the Salt Lake City Board of Adjustment (414 City & County Building), and that on the 29th day of November, 1982, Case No. 9109 by Midwest Office Supply was heard by the Board. The applicant requested a variance on the property at 987 South West Temple Street to erect a free-standing double-face sign which would not maintain the required setback and would exceed the permitted 25 foot height limit by 20 feet in a Commercial "C-1" District, the legal description of said property being as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of Lot 9, Block 22, Five Acre Plat "A", Big Field Survey, running North 200.1 feet; East 188.65 feet; South 200.1 feet; West 188.65 feet to the point of beginning.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously passed that a variance be granted to allow a 45 foot high sign to be erected which exceeds the ordinance by 20 feet, provided the farthest projection of the sign is no closer to the street than the existing building. If a permit has not been taken out in six months the variance will expire.
