for the sum of valuable consideration, the receipt of DOLLARS, which is hereby acknowledged,
the following described tracts of land in Davis County, State of Utah: to-wit:

Beginning at a point 669.0 feet North and 207.00 feet West of the Southeast corner of the Northeast quarter of Section 11, Township 3 North, Range 1 West, Salt Lake Meridian, and running thence South 64° CC! West 756.7 feet, along the County Highway; thence South 650.00 feet; thence North 64° CC! East 1363.00 feet; thence North ----- East, along a fence 100 feet; thence North 7° CC! East 80 feet to the State Highway; thence North 57° O4! West 783.4 feet, more or less, along the State Highway to the point of beginning, containing therein 20 acres. (The above description is intended to convey exactly 20 acres.)

Reserving and excepting, however, a right of way through ditches on said land as at present located.
