## ABSTRACT OF FINDINGS AND ORDER

I, Mildred G. Snider, being first duly sworn, depose and say that I am the Secretary of the Salt Lake City Board of Adjustment (414 City & County Building), and that on the 20th day of August, 1984, <u>Case No. 9694</u> by Western Tele-Communications, Inc. was heard by the Board. The applicant requested a variance on the property at 50 North 1200 West Street to erect a masonry long distance telephone relay station building which would not have frontage on a dedicated street in an Industrial "M-1" District, the legal description of said property being as follows:

Beginning at the center of a  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " diameter fence post in a 6.0 foot chain link fence, which post is S  $89^{\circ}58'36"$  W along the lot line 75.54 feet and N  $0^{\circ}00'55"$  W 34.32 feet from the southeast corner of Lot 3, Block 55, Plat "C", Salt Lake City Survey and running thence S  $89^{\circ}58'36"$  W 130.00 feet; thence N  $0^{\circ}00'55"$  W 100.00 feet; thence N  $89^{\circ}58'36"$  E 130.00 feet to a 6.0 foot chain link fence; thence S  $0^{\circ}00'55"$  E along said fence 100.00 feet to the point of beginning.

It was moved, seconded and unanimously passed that a variance be granted to erect a masonry long distance telephone relay station building with a 130 foot freestanding tower and antenna, the building and the property which would not have frontage on a dedicated street, provided the petitioner obtain and present for the file a permanent deeded right-of-way from the property owner to the north. If a permit has not been taken out in six months, the variance will expire.
