

TO ALL WHIOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

Under and by virtue of Section 42, Chapter 64 of the Session Laws of 1899, of the State of Utah, as amended by Chapter 35, Session Laws of 1901, and by authority of a resolution of the State Board of Land Commissioners of the State of Utah, dated April 1st, 1902;

I Heber M. Wells, Governor and Ex-Officio President of the State Board of Land Commissioners, without compensation, since it appears that no damage will result therefrom, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah in such cases made and provided, do hereby grant and convey, in the name and by the authority of the State of Utah, unto The Telluride Power Company, a corporation of Colorado, grantee, and ^{to} its successors and assigns, forever, rights of way for the erection, maintenance and operation of lines for the transmission of electric energy and for telephonic purposes on, over, and across the parcels of land hereinafter described.

This grant shall apply only to those interests in said parcels of land which are now held or may hereafter be acquired by the State of Utah therein and is given subject to existing rights therein of private parties.

Said parcels of land, situated in Weber County, Utah, are described as follows:
