## THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

To All To Whom these presents shall come, Creeting:

WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City, Utah, has been deposited in the General Land Office, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the Act of Congress of May 20, 1862, "To Secure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Hyrum C.

Turnbeaugh has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the Lot eleven of Section one in Township forty-two south of Range fifteen west and the Lot seven and the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section six and the Lot one of Section seven in Township forty-two south of Range fourteen west of the Salt Lake Meridian, Utah, containing one hundred sixty-one acres and sixty-two hundredths of an acre, according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, on file in the General Land Office:

NOW KNOW YE, That there is, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said Hyrum C. Turnbeaugh the tract of Land above described; TO HAVE AND TO HOLD unto the said Hyrum C.
