ORDINANCE NO. 1030

DATE April 11, 1988

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE STREET NAMES IN THE OAKS OF WASATCH P.U.D. PLATS A AND B.

The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Salt Lake ordains as follows:

SECTION I. That the names of the following public streets in The Oaks at Wasatch P.U.D. Plats A and B of record in the Salt Lake County Recorder's Office be and the same are hereby changed as follows:

	From:	To:
Plat A:	"Wasatch Cove Lane" "Wasatch Oaks Lane"	"Cobble Brook Drive" "Clover Spring Lane"
Plat B:	"Oak Brook Lane" "Oak Springs Lane" "Oak Creek Lane"	"Lone Brook Lane" "Lost Spring Lane" "Rustic Spring Lane"

SECTION II. (1) The Board of County Commissioners finds and is satisfied that said street name changes are necessary to avoid confusion because the names used in this subdivision are too similar to names already in use; said street name changes have been approved by the County Address Coordinator and the Development Services Division; that said name change will not be detrimental to the general public interest; that neither the public nor any person will be materially injured thereby; and that in view of the foregoing, said street name changes accordingly should be made.

(2) The Salt Lake County Recorder shall record this ordinance and make the necessary changes on the official plats and records of the County to effectuate the purpose hereof.


SECTION III. This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after its passage and upon at least one publication in a newspaper published and having general circulation in Salt Lake County.
