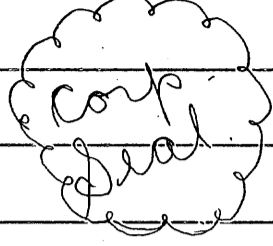


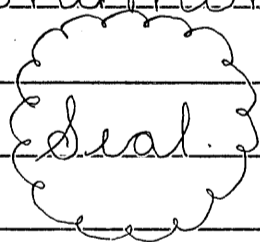

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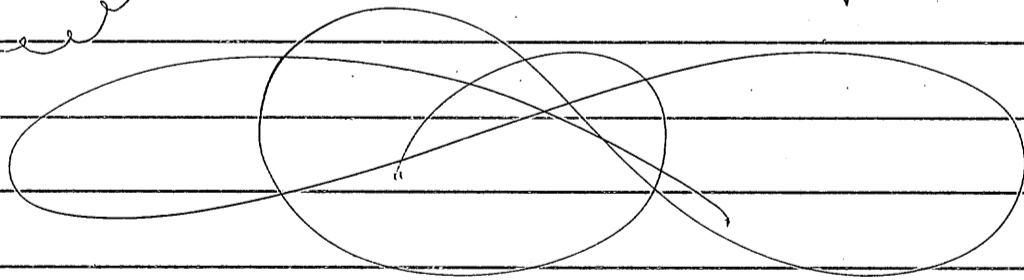

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sum of Two Hundred Fifty (\$250.00) Dollars and all legal interest thereon accrued, as fully appears by the certificate of the proper officers, now on file in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Utah;

Now Therefore I William Spry, Governor, in consideration of the premises, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, in such case made and provided, do issue this Patent, in the name and by the authority of the State of Utah, hereby granting and confirming unto the said Andrew J. Pendleton and to his heirs and assigns forever, the following piece or parcel of land, situate in the County of Utah State aforesaid, to-wit:

The South West quarter (SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of the North East quarter (NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>); the North Half (N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>) of the North East quarter (NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>); and the North Half (N<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>) of the North West quarter (NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>) of section Fourteen (14) in Township Five (5) South Range One (1) West of the Salt Lake Meridian, containing Two Hundred (200) acres according to the said certificate To Have And To Hold the above described and granted premises unto the said Andrew J. Pendleton and to his heirs and assigns forever, subject to any easement or right of way of the public, to use all such highways as may have been established according to law, over the same or any part thereof and subject also to all rights of way for ditches, tunnels, and telephone and transmission lines that may have been constructed by authority of the United States.

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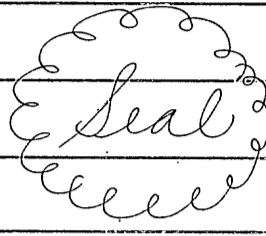

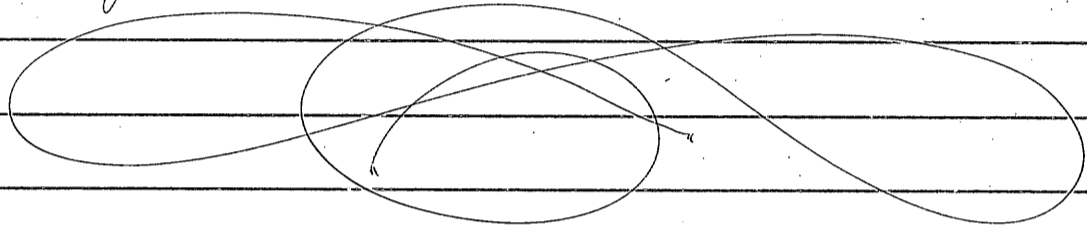

Quit-Claim Deed.

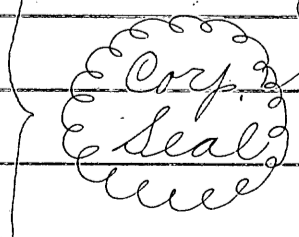
