AN ORDINANCE.

AN ORDINANCE VACATING certain portions of streets and alleys in Highland Park Addition in the Northwest Quarter of Section 2., Township 1 South, Range 1 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

Be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Salt Lake City, Utah:

SECTION 1. That all that part of the alleys and streets north of First South Street south of the right of way of the S. P., L. A. & S. L. R. R. Company, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 1, Blk. 1, Highland Park Addition of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 2, T. 1 S., R. 1 W., S. L. B. and M., thence north 64 feet, more or less, to the southerly right of way boundary of the S. P., L. A. & S. L. R. R.; thence northeasterly along said boundary 12.7 feet more or less to the west line of Lot 2, Blk. 1, aforesaid Highland Park Addition.; thence south 68 feet more or less to the north line of First South Street; thence west 12 feet to place of beginning;

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 5, Blk. 2, Highland park Addition of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 2, T. 1 S., R. 1 W., S. L. B. and M., thence north 150 feet more or less to the southerly right of way boundary of the S. P., L. A. & S. L. R. R., thence northeasterly along said boundary 12.4 feet more or less to the west line of Lot 11, Blk. 1, aforesaid Highland Park Addition, thence South 153 feet more or less to the north line of First South Street, thence west 12 feet to place of beginning;

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 4, Blk. 1, Highland Park Addition of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 2, T. 1 S., R. 1 W., S. L. B. and M., thence north 104 feet more or less to the southerly right of way boundary of the S. P., L. A. & S. L. R. R., thence northeasterly along said boundary 62.1 feet more or less to the west line of Lot 1, Blk. 2 aforesaid Highland Park Addition; thence south 120 feet more or less to the north line of First South Street, thence west 60 feet to place of beginning.

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 6, Blk. 2, Highland Park Addition of the N. W. 1/4 of Sec. 2, T. 1 S., R. 1 W., S. L. B. and M., thence North 168 feet more or less to the southerly right of way boundary of the S. P., L. A. & S. L. R. R., thence northeasterly along said boundary 60.3 feet more or less to the west line of Lot 1, Blk. 3, aforesaid Highland Park Addition, thence South 174 feet more or less to the north line of First South Street, thence west 50 feet to place of beginning; be and the same are hereby vacated and declared no longer to be public alleys, streets or ways.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect thirty-one days after its first publication.
