THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City, Utah, has been desposited in the Geral Land Office, whereby it appears that, pursuant to the act of Congress of May 20, 1662, "To Seaure Homesteads to Actual Settlers on the Public Domain," and the acts supplemental thereto, the claim of Johanna A. Clark, widow of John Clark, has been established and duly consummated, in conformity to law, for the

south half of the northeast quarter, the southeast quarter, the northwest quarter, and the Lot eight of Section eleven and the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter of Section twelve in Township two south of Range four east of the Selt Lake Meridian, Utah, containing four hundred seventy-nine acres and eighty-eight hundredths of an acre,

according to the Official Plat of the Survey of the said Land, on file in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE:

NOW KNOW YE, That thereis, therefore, granted by the UNITED STATES unto the said claiment the tract of Land above described;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the seid tract of Land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the seid claiment and to the heirs and assigns of the said claiment forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manfacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts; and there is reserved from the lands hereby granted, a right of way thereon for ditches or canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

Excepting and reserving, however, to the United States all the coal and other minerals in the lands so entered and patented, together with the right to prospect for, mine, and remove the same pursuant to the provisions and limitations of the Act of December 29, 1916(39 Stat., 862).

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I, Herbert Hoover, President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.
