Grantee, of Salt Lake City, Utah for the  
sum of One and no/100 DOLLARS,

the following described tract of land in Wasatch County, State of Utah,

Beginning on the south side line of Lowndale Addition at the point of intersection of the East track of said Salt Lake & Ogden Railway and running thence north 38° 15' 34" 1095 ft. more or less to the North line of land owned by Sanford Lutz and granting a right of way 80 feet wide on the westerly side of said line and on the easterly side, all land lying between said center line and a certain highway, where not bounded by said highway, 66 feet is granted on said East side.

Also, beginning on said center line of railway at a point about 100 feet south from the N. E. Cor. of the S. E. 1/4 of the N. 21. 1/4 Sec. 6, and running thence S. 38° 15' 34" 685 feet, more or less, to the East line of land formerly owned by T. M. Bradley and granting 80 feet width on the Westerly side and 66 feet width on the Easterly side of such line.

sum of One and no/100 DOLLARS,

the following described tract of land in Weber County, State of Utah,

Beginning on the South side line of Lowndale Addition at the point of intersection of the East track of said Salt Lake & Ogden Railway and running thence South 38° 15' W. 1095 ft. more or less to the North line of land owned by Sanford Lipe and granting a right of way 80 feet wide on the westerly side of said line and on the easterly side, all land lying between said center line and a certain highway; where not bounded by said highway, 66 feet is granted on said East side.

Also, beginning on said center line of railway at a point about 400 feet South from the N.E. Cor. of the S.E. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 Sec. 6, in Township 45 North Range 1 West, S. & M. and running thence S. 38° 15' W. 685 feet, more or less, to the East line of land formerly owned by T. M. Bradley and granting 80 feet width on the Westerly side and 66 feet width on the Easterly side of such line.
