NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ESTABLISH THE MILLARD COUNTY FIRE SERVICE DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on July 9, 1985, the Board of County Commissioners of Millard County, Utah, adopted Resolution No. 85-07-09 declaring that the public health, convenience and necessity require the establishment of a special service district in the county to be called the Millard County Fire Service District for the purpose of providing fire protection services within portions of Millard County, Utah. Said resolution was thereafter amended by Resolution No. 85-09-03. Resolution No. 85-09-03 provides for a public hearing on the establishment of the Millard County Fire Service District at the Millard County Commission Chambers in the Millard County Offices, 60 South Main Street, Fillmore, Utah, at the hour of 2:00 p.m. on October 8, 1985.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED DISTRICT

The proposed district shall have the following boundaries within Millard County, Utah:

Beginning at the southeast corner of section 24, township 17 south, range 2 west, Salt Lake base and meridian, on range line between ranges 1 and 2 west, thence west to the southwest corner of section 22 near the summit of Sevier hill; thence morth to the southeast corner of section 16; thence west on section line to the summit of the range separating 0ak Creek district from the Little valley; thence northerly following the last mentioned summit to its point of intersection, if prolonged, with the middle of the channel of the Sevier river; thence southwesterly down the middle of said channel to the mouth of the lower Sevier canyon; thence west on the township line between townships 14 and 15 south to the boundary of the state; thence south to a point west of a point two miles south of the south side of Fort Wilden on Cove creek; thence east to the summit of the range separating the Sevier valley from the Pahvant and Round valleys; thence to the southwest corner of section 31, township 25 south, range 5 west; thence east one-half mile; thence north the miles; thence east one-half mile;

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE MILLARD COUNTY FIRE SERVICE DISTRICT TO PROVIDE THOSE SERVICES SET FORTH IN THE NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ESTABLISH THE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, on September 3, 1985, the Board of County Commissioners adopted a Notice of Intention to establish the Millard County Fire Service District; and

WHEREAS, after proper notification by publication, a hearing was held on October 8, 1985, wherein all interested parties were invited to submit written protests against the establishment of the District or against the services to be provided within the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners closed the public hearing and pursuant to statute, invited qualified voters of the territory proposed to be included within the District and owners of taxable property within the District to file written protests against the establishment of the proposed District with the Board of County Commissioners for an additional fifteen (15) day period; and

WHEREAS, said fifteen day protest period has expired during which time the Board of County Commissioners has received the following written protests:

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that fewer than 50% of the voters of the territory proposed to be included within the District and owners of the assessed value of the taxable property within the District filed written protests against the establishment of the District or against the services to be provided within the District; and

WHEREAS, the incorporated municipalities of Oak City, Leamington, Lynndyl, Hinckley, Delta, Scipio, Holden, and Meadow have all consented by resolution to their inclusion within the District; and
