DECLARATION OF BUILDING AND USE RESTRICTIONS

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PREAMBLE PART A.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT, WHEREAS, the undersigned, being the owners of the following decreed County [DAVIS. real property located in the City of A State of Utah, to-wit:

Lots to 100 inclusive, advise redivision; according to the plat thereof, as recorded in the office of the County Recorder of said County. Lots, 1779 as recorded in the office of the County Recorder of sald County.

and do declare that all conveyances of said lots shall be made subject to the following conditions, restrictions and stipulations;

RESIDENTIAL AREA COVENANTS PART B.

- 1. Land Use and Building Type. No lot shall be used except for residential purposes, No building shall be erected, altered, placed or permitted to remain on any lot other than one detached single-family dwelling not to exceed two stories in height and private garages and/or carports for not more than three vehicles. All construction to be of new materials, except that used brick may be used with prior written approval of the Architectural Control Committee.
- Architectural Control. No building shall be erected, placed, or altered on any lot until the construction plans and specifications and a plan showing the location of the structure have been approved by the Architectural Control Committee as to quality of workmanship and materials, harmony of external design with existing structures, and as to location with respect to topography and finish grade elevation. No fence or wall shall be erected, placed or altered on any lot nearer to any street than the front building setback line unless similarly approved. Approval shall be as provided in Part C.
- Dwelling Cost, Quality and Size. No dwelling shall be permitted on any lot at a cost less than \$ 27,000.00 exclusive of lot, based upon cost levels prevailing on the date of less than \$... these covenants are recorded, it being the incention and purpose of the covenants to assure that all dwellings shall be of a quality of workmanship and materials substantially the same or better than that which can be produced on the date these covenants are recorded at the minimum cost stated herein for the minimum permitted dwelling size. The main floor area of the main structure, exclusive of one-story open porches and garages, shall be not less than 750 square feet.

Building Location.

(a) No building shall be located on any lot nearer than 25 feet to the front lot line, or nearer than 20 feet to any side street line.

(b) No dwelling shall be located on any lot nearer than 10 feet on one side and 2 feet on the located on any lot nearer than 10 feet on one to any interior lot line, side and 3 feet on the other side except that a one-foot minimum side yard shall be permitted for a garage or other permitted accessory building located 45 feet or more from the front building setback line. No dwelling shall be located on any interior lot nearer than 35 feet to the rear lot line. Detached garages or other permitted accessory buildings may be located seven feet or more from the rear lot line, so long as such buildings do not encroach upon any easements. No building shall be located nearer than 10 feet to the recorded Gas line easement.

- (c) For the purpose of this covenant, eaves, steps, and open porches shall not be considered as a part of a building, provided, however, that this shall not be construed to permit any portion of any building on a lot to encroach upon another lot.
- 5. Lot Area and Width. No dwelling shall be erected or placed on any lot having a width of less than 50 feet at the front building setback line nor shall any dwelling be erected or placed on any lot having an area of less than 5000 square feet, except that a dwelling may be erected or placed on all corner and cul-de-sac lots as shown on the recorded plat, provided that the above yard clearances are maintained.
- 6. Easement. Easements for installation and maintenance of utilities and drainage facilities are reserved as shown on the recorded plat and over the rear 10 feet of each lot. Within these easements, no structure, planting or other material shall be placed or permitted to remain which may damage or interfere with the installation

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and maintenance of utilities, or which may a top the direction of the of the element channels in the ensembles. - 7. Mulsances. No noxious or offensive activity chall be carried on apen my tot, nor shall anything be done thereon which may be or may become an analysis. Or our makes to the neighborhood. He clothes drying or storage of any articles which are unalisably in the opinion of the Architectural Control Cosmittee will be pevalited in emports, unless in enclosed areas designed for such purpose. No automobiles, truitees, beats, or other vehicles are to be stored on streets or front or mide form unless they are in running condition, presents licensed and are being regularly uncel.
- 8. Temporary Structures. No structure of a temporary character, trailer, nasement, tent, shack, garage, barn or other outbuildings shall be used on any lot at any time as a residence either temporarily or permanently. To Hobite Homes are permitted.
- 9. Signs. No sign of any kind shall be displayed to the public view on any lot except one professional sign of not more than one square foot, one sign of not more than five square feet advertising the property for sale or rent, or signs used by a builder to advertise the property during the construction and sales period.
- 10. Livestock and Poultry. No animals, livestock, or poultry of any kind shall be raised, bred or kept on any lot, except that dogs, cats or other household pets may be kept provided that they are not kept, bred, or maintained for any commercial purpose and are restricted to the owner's premises or on leach under handler's control.
- 11. Garbage and Refuse Disposal. No lot shall be used or maintained as a dumping ground for rubbish. Trash, garbage or other waste shall not be kept except in sanitary containers. All incinerators or other equipment for the storage or disposal of such material shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition. Each lot and its abutting street are to be kept free of trash, weeds and other refuse by the lot owner. No unsightly materials or other objects are to be stored on any lot in view of the general public.
- 12. Sight Distance at Intersection. No fence, wall, hedge, or shrub planting which obstructs sight lines at elevations between 2 and 6 feet above the readways shall be placed or permitted to remain on any corner lot within the triangular area formed by the street property lines and a line cornecting them at points 25 feet from the intersection of the street lines or in case of a rounded property corner from the intersection of the street property lines extended. The same sight-line limitations shall apply on a driveway or alley pavement. No tree shall be permitted to remain within such distance of such intersections unless the foliage line is maintained at sufficient height to prevent obstruction of such sight lines.
- 13. Oil and Mining Operations. No oil drilling, oil development operations, oil refining, quarrying or mining operations of any kind shall be permitted upon or in any lot, nor shall oil wells, tanks, tunnels, mineral excavations or shafts be permitted upon or in any lot. No derrick or other structure designed for use in boring for oil or natural gas shall be erected, maintained, or permitted upon any lot.
- 14. Landscaping. Trees, lawns, shrubs, or other plantings provided by the developer shall be properly nurtured and maintained or replaced at the property owner's expense upon request of the Architectural Control Committee.
- 15. Slope and Drainage Control. No structure, planting or other material shall be placed or permitted to remain or other activities undertaken which may damage or interf re with established slope ratios, create erosion or sliding problems, or which may change the direction of flow of drainage channels or obstruct or retard the flow of water through drainage channels. The slope control areas of each lot and all improvements in them shall be maintained continuously by the owner of the lot, except for those improvement, for which a public authority or utility company is responsible.

PART C. ARCHITECTURAL CONTROL COMMITTEE

1. Membership. A majority of the committee may designate a representative to act for it. In the event of death or resignation of any member of the committee, the remaining members of the committee shall have full authority to select a successor. Neither the
