Blood, Governor, in consideration of the premises, and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, in such case made and provided do issue this Patent, in the name and by the authority of the Stateof Utah, hereby granting and confirming unto the said John S. Boyden and to his heirs and assigns forever, the following piece or parcel of land situate in the County of Summit, state aforesaid, to Wit:

The East Half (E_8^1) of the Mortheast Quarter (NE1); Northeast Quarter (NE1) of the Southeast Quarter (\underline{SE}) of Section Eighteen (18), in Township Two (2) North, Range Five (5) East, of the Selt Lake Meridian,

(Reserving to the State of Utah, all coal and other minerals, in the above lands, and to it, or persons authorized by it, the right to prospect for, mine and remove coal and other minerals from the same, upon compliance with the conditions and subject to the limitations of Title 86-bapter 1, Revised Statutes of Utah 1933 and amendments thereto.)

containing one Hundred Twenty and No/100 acres according to the said certificate. (120.00)

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described granted premises unto the said John S. boyden and to his heirs, and assigns forever, subject to any easement or right of way of the public to use all such highways as may have been established according to law, over the same or any part thereof, and subject also to all right of way for ditches, tunnels. and telephone and transmission lines that may have been constructed by authority of the United States.
