ORDINANCE #98-7

AN ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE NAME OF 9800 SOUTH WESTBOUND FROM 700 EAST TO SANDY CITY'S WEST BORDER (9800 SOUTH TO 10000 SOUTH) TO SEGO LILY DRIVE.

BE IT KNOWN AND REMEMBERED that the City Council of Sandy City, State of Utah, finds and determines as follows:

- 1. The Sandy City Police Department has requested that the name of 9800 South westbound from 700 East to Sandy City's west border (9800 South to 10000 South) be changed to Sego Lily Drive to facilitate public safety response; and
