The Resolution was thereupon signed by the Chairman, was attested and countersigned by the County Clerk, and was ordered recorded in the official records of the County.

The Resolution is as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 10-05-93-8

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE GUNNISON VALLEY HOSPITAL SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT TO AUTHORIZE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS AS SET FORTH IN THE NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CREATE THE DISTRICT AND TO APPOINT AN ADMINISTRATIVE CONTROL BOARD FOR THE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Sanpete County, Utah, believes that the public health, convenience and necessity require the construction, acquisition, enlargement, operation and equipping of a hospital together with all appurtenant hospital and health care facilities, including fixtures and medical equipment, furnishings and all appurtenances as well as any other of the authorized services and related facilities permitted for a special service district under Title 17A, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, within a specified area, hereinafter particularly described, of Sanpete County and therefore it is desirable to incorporate said area into a Special Service District pursuant to the provisions of the Utah Special Service District Act, Chapter 2, Title 17A, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended (the "Act"), and Article XIV, Section 8 of the Constitution of Utah; and

WHEREAS, all property included within the boundaries of said proposed Special Service District will be benefited by the creation thereof; and

WHEREAS, none of the area to be contained within the boundaries of said proposed Gunnison Valley Hospital Special Service District is also within the boundaries of any other special service district established by said County to construct, acquire, enlarge, operate and equip of a hospital together with all appurtement hospital and health care facilities, including fixtures

and medical equipment, furnishings and all appurtenances, as well, as any other of the authorized services and related facilities permitted for a special service district under Title 17A, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, nor, except as recited in the paragraph next following is the area within any other district presently providing similar services; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Notice of Intention Resolution adopted August 17, 1993 there was published in the Gunnison Valley News, a newspaper of general circulation in the geographical area of the proposed special service district and designated as the official newspaper in that Resolution, a Notice of Intention to Create the Gunnison Valley Hospital Special Service District on the 25th day of August and the 1st, 8th and 15th days of September, 1993; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of said Board of Commissioners has stated that no additional protests had been received in her office during the 15-day protest period following the September 21, 1993 protest hearing, that less than 50% of the qualified voters of the territory proposed to be included with the proposed special service district and the owners of less than 50% of the taxable value of the taxable property included within the proposed special service district have filed written protests against the establishment of said district or against the specified type of services set out in the Resolution adopted at the August 17, 1993 meeting;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Sanpete County, State of Utah, as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Commissioners of Sanpete County, Utah (the "Board of Commissioners") believes that the public health, convenience and necessity require the construction of the improvements identified and described in the Notice of Intention concerning the establishment of the Gunnison Valley Hospital Special Service District (the "District").

Section 2. The Board of Commissioners has heretofore considered each and every protest filed and has heard each and every person who wished to be heard in protest against the creation of the District or the construction of any of the improvements therein, or on any other matter pertinent to the District.

Section 3. The Board of Commissioners hereby finds that less than 50% of the qualified voters of the territory proposed to be included with the proposed special service district and the owners of less than 50% of the taxable value of taxable property included within the proposed special service district have filed written protests against the establishment of said District or against the specified type of service, within said District, proposed to be furnished.

Section 4. The improvements proposed and described in, the Notice of Intention to create the District are hereby authorized, and the District is hereby created.

Section 5. The boundaries of the Gunnison Valley Hospital Special Service District shall include the following described tracts of land in Sanpete County, Utah:

All of Township 18 South, Range 1 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

All of Township 18 South, Range 1 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

All of Township 19 South, Range 1 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

All of Township 19 South, Range 1 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

All of Township 19 South, Range 2 East Salt Lake Base and Meridian, EXCEPTING Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12.

All of that part of the following Townships situated or located in Sanpete County, as Sanpete County as described in §17-1-23, U.C.A. 1953, the South Boundary of Sanpete County being described in §17-1-24, U.C.A. 1953:

Township 17 South, Range 1-1/2 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, EXCEPTING Sections 6, 7 and 18.

Township 17 South, Range 1 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

Township 18 South, Range 2 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

Township 19 South, Range 2 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

Township 20 South, Range 2 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

Township 20 South, Range 1 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

Township 20 South, Range 1 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

Township 20 South, Range 2 East, Salt Lake Base and Meridian.

Section 6. The District shall be administered by an Administrative Control Board which is hereby delegated, without limitation, the power to act as the governing authority of the District and to exercise all or any of the powers and immunities including, but not limited to, those provided for in Sections 17A-2-1314, 17A-2-1316, 17A-2-1317, 17A-2-1318, 17A-2-1319, 17A-2-1320, 17A-2-1321, 17A-2-1322, 17A-2-1323, 17A-2-1324, 17A-2-1325 and 17A-2-1326, of the Utah Special Service District Act and any and all other authority, power, purpose, immunity and privilege provided by law or authorized in the pursuit of the purposes for which the District is created, or any that may be in the future allowed. Said Administrative Control Board shall have the power to levy a tax on the taxable property of the District, to issue bonds payable from taxes and to call and hold an election for the authorization the tax or bonds with the approval of the Board of Commissioners.

section 7. Administrative Control Board members shall be paid at a per diem rate to be set by resolution of the Board of Commissioners

Section 8. The membership of the Administrative Control Board of the District shall consist of seven (7) members, each of whom shall be appointed by the Board of Commissioners. The Board of Commissioners shall appoint the initial seven members to serve from October 5, 1993 until December 31, 1993. On January 1, 1994, new members shall be selected and approved by the Governing Body of the respective communities and the medical staff of Gunnison Valley Hospital. The seven (7) appointed shall be selected two (2) by the Governing Body of Gunnison, one (1) each by the Governing Bodies of Centerfield, Fayette and Mayfield, one (1) by the medical staff of Gunnison Valley Hospital, and one (1) "At-Large" member. One (1) member shall be selected each by the Governing Bodies of Centerfield, Fayette, Gunnison and Mayfield for a term of two (2) years. One (1) member shall be selected each by the Governing Body of Gunnison and the medical staff of Gunnison Valley Hospital for a term of four (4) years. An "At Large" member additionally shall be selected by Centerfield for a 4-year term and thereafter on a rotating basis by Fayette, Gunnison and Mayfield for a term of four (4) years. The At Large member shall serve succeeding terms of four (4) years and alternately be selected by the Governing Body of each community, namely: Centerfield, Fayette, Gunnison and Mayfield.

Section 9. The Board of Commissioners hereby appoints as the initial membership of the Administrative Control Board the following members:

Neil Mellor Fayette, Utah
Mary Hill Gunnison, Utah
Kerry Blood Gunnison, Utah
Bruce Blackham Gunnison, Utah
Lee Sorensen Mayfield, Utah
Jan Christensen, M.D. Gunnison Valley Hospital

Lee Sorensen shall serve as Chairman of the Administrative Control Board and Mark Stoddard shall serve as Secretary until their successors are elected and qualified as provided in §17A-1-101(1) and, subject to the provisions of this Section 9, the provisions of §17A-1-303, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended.

Vacancies of the appointed members of the Administrative Control Board, other than by expiration of term, shall be filled by election as provided in §17A-1-101(1) and, subject to the provisions of this Section 9, the provisions of §17A-1-303, Utah Code Annotated 1953, as amended, for the unexpired term of the members whose vacancy is filled.
