REASSIGNMENT CLAUSE

In the event that Assignee shall desire to surrender said lease, Assignee shall notify Assignors in writing thereof sixty (60) days prior to the next rental paying date under said lease. If Assignors desire to reacquire such lease as to the lands surrendered, Assignors shall notify Assignee within thirty (30) days after receipt of such notice, and thereupon Assignee shall reassign said lease to Assignors; provided, however, that if Assignors do not within thirty (30) days after receipt of such notice from Assignee elect to reacquire said lease, Assignee shall then have the right to surrender said lease, and in the event of such surrender Assignee shall have no further obligations under this assignment.
