ORDINANCE NO. 754

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY TO THE CITY, AND EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, a petition in writing requesting the annexation to Layton City of certain real property, signed by a majority of the owners and by the owners of not less than one-third in value of the said real property, as shown by the last assessment rolls, has been filed with the Layton City Recorder, and

WHEREAS, said petition was accompanied by a plat of said real property made under the supervision of a competent surveyor, showing the size and location of said real property and showing that the same is contiguous to the present corporate limits of Layton City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LAYTON, UTAH:

Section I. That the following described real property is hereby annexed to Layton City, and the corporate limits of the city are hereby extended to include said real property:

A part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 9, a part of the Northwest Quarter of Section 10, Township 4 North, Range 1 West, Salt Lake Base & Meridian, U.S. Survey; beginning at a point which is South 0°07'20" West 2056.34 feet along the section line from the Northwest corner of said Section 10 and running thence South 88°36'10" East 21.81 feet; thence South 0°07'20" West 100.00 feet to an existing fence to the East line of Fairfield Road; thence North 0°07'20" East 100.00 feet along said East line; South 88°36'10" East 128.23 feet to the poing of beginning.

Section II. That the City Recorder is directed to file a certified copy of the plat of said real property and a certified copy of this ordinance of annexation with the Davis County Recorder.

Section III. Effective Date. This ordinance is effective immediately.
