EASEMENT

Reed and Margaret Atkinson, his wife, grantors of Francis, County of Summit, State of Utah, hereby licenses and permits the State Road Commission of Utah, Licensee, for the sum of Fifty and no/100 Dollars to use the following described premises situated upon the grantors land in the:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 33, T. 2 S. R.6 E. S.L.M. in Summit County, Utah, for the purpose of reconstruction thereon an irrigation ditch and appurtenant parts thereof;

A strip of land 15.0 ft. wide, adjoining southerly the present southerly right of way strip of highway known as Project No. S-147 the center line of said strip being described as follows:

Beginning at a point 38.5 ft. perpendicularly distant southerly from the center line of survey of said project at Engineer's Station 563/05, which point is approximately 39 ft. south and approximately 539 ft. N. 89°47' E. from the NW corner of said Section 33; thence N. 89°47' E. 115.0 ft., more or less to the east boundary line of said grantors land, containing 0.04 acre, more or less.

After said irrigation ditch is reconstructed on above described premises at the expense of Licensee, said Licensee is thereafter relieved of any further claim or demand for costs, damages or maintenance charges which may accrue against said irrigation ditch or appurtenant parts thereof.

CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER, STATE OF UTAH.

Application No. 17546.

CERTIFICATE NO. 3576

Names and Address of appropriator: Union Pacific Railroad Company c/o Supt., Union Pacific Railroad Co., Depot, Salt Lake City, Utah.

Source of Supply: Underground water in Summit County, Utah, Weber River Drainage Area.

Quantity of water: Thirty/one thousandths (0.030) second - foot Priority of Right April 20, 1946.

Period and Nature of Use: From January 1 to December 31, inclusive of each year for Domestic purposes.

WHEREAS It has been made to appear to the satisfaction of the undersigned that the appropriation of water has been perfected in accordance with the Laws of Utah: THEREFORE, Be it known that I, Ed. H. Watson the duly appointed qualified, and acting State Engineer, by authority of the laws of Utah, do hereby certify that said appropriator is entitled to the use of water as herein set out, subject to prior rights, if any, for division and use as follows, to wit:

The water appropriated is yielded by a pump well fully cased with a 6-in new steel casing, driven to a depth of 65 ft. below ground surface, the first 40 ft. below ground surface being enclosed within an additional new steel casing 8- in. in diameter, situated N. 587.5ft. and E. 232.1 ft. from SW cor. Sec. 3, T. 3 N. R. 4 E. S.L.B.&M. The water is diverted by means of a reciprocal hand pump, located over the well. The water appropriated is intermittently pumped by hand and carried in vessels to two houses
