ORDINANCE

3-3 - 79

AN ORDINANCE OF WEBER COUNTY, UTAH, prohibiting the discharge of firearms in the vicinity of 10000 West 900 South, being within Weber County, State of Utah, and more specifically hereinafter described.

WHEREAS, the Western Zirconium Company has constructed a facility in the vicinity of 10000 West 900 South, in Weber County, Utah: and

WHEREAS, said facility includes numer ous storage tanks containing toxic gases and chemicals; and

WHEREAS, the discharge of firearms in the vicinity poses a definite hazard to said storage tanks; and personnel in the area in the want of a puncture;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of Weber County, Utah hereby ordains:

SECTION I. Discharge of any firearm within the following described area of Weber County, Utah shall be unlawful.

All of Sections 7, 8, 9, 16, 17 and 18, and part of Sections 19, 20, and 21, Township 6 North, Range 3 West, and all of Sections 12, 13, and part of Sections 24. Township 6 North, Range 4 West, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, U. S. Survey; more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of said Section 9, Township 6 North, Range 3 West, running thence South 12,560.0 feet more or less along the East lines of said Sections 9, 16, and 21 to Southern Pacific Railroad North thence Westerly along said Right-of-Way, 4 Right-of-Way; miles to the West boundary line of said Section 24; thence North along the West boundary line of said Sections 24, 13, and 12, 12,560.0 feet more or less to the Northwest corner of said Section 12; thence East along the North boundary lines of said Sections 12, 7, 8 and 9 to the point of beginning.

Containing 6,090 acres, more or less.

SECTION 2. A firearm means a pistol, revolver, shotgun, rifle, and/or any device that could be used as a weapon from which is expelled a projectile by any force.
