

AGREEMENT FOR CHANGE OF ACCESS OPENINGS

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 26th day of November, A.D. 1958, by and between the STATE ROAD COMMISSION OF UTAH, first party, and Hope M. Mohr and Andrew J. Mohr, her husband, of Heber City, County of Wasatch, State of Utah, second party,

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, a certain parcel of land located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 5, T. 4 S., R. 5 E. S.L.M. and adjoining the westerly right of way line of highway known as Project No. 019-1, has access to said highway for one 16-foot opening opposite Highway Engineers Station 102+00, as granted in a deed recorded as entry No. 78077 in Book 32, Page 389 of the records of Wasatch County, Utah, and

WHEREAS, both parties desire to change the hereinabove described access opening to a more desirable location,

NOW THEREFORE, it is agreed by and between the parties hereto that the hereinabove described access opening be hereby released and relinquished and shall be forever closed to the second party, their heirs, successors or assigns. In exchange for said closing the first party hereby grants to the second party, their heirs, successors or assigns, the right of access to the nearest roadway of said highway over and across the westerly right of way line for two 30-foot sections, which said sections center at points directly opposite Highway Engineers Station 98+71 and 101+46.
