FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION of the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) to the undersigned in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, ELEANOR FETERSON URE, and J. EDWIN URE and JEAN F. URE, his wife of the County of Summit, State of Utah, hereinafter called Grantor, does hereby grant to SALT LAKE FIPE LINE COMPANY, a hevada Corporation, hereinafter called Grantee, the right to install, maintain, operate, repair, renew, reconstruct, alter, change and remove a cathodic pipe protection system consisting of an electric rectifier mounted upon a concrete mat and/or pole or other support; protective fencing around said pole or mat and rectifier if desired; and a safety switch mounted upon a wooden pole to which power wires and a meter may be attached by a public utility to supply power for the operation of said protection system; a series of electrodes (pieces of pipe or other materials) placed underground; cable connecting said rectifier to said electrodes and to Grantee's pipe lines and to such other pipe lines as Grantee, at any time and from time to time may elect to protect with said system; cable, wires or conduit connecting said meter to said safety switch and rectifier; together with appurtenances; with the right of ingress and egress to and from the same, within that certain parcel of land situate in the County of Summit, State of Utah, and described as follows:

All that portion of the Southeast quarter (SEL) of the Northeast quarter (NEL) of Section 24, lownship 2 South, Range 5 East of the Salt Lake Meridian, which lies southerly of the Kamas-Keetley road.
