TRANSMISSION LINE EASEMENT

Cottrell and Elizabeth Cotterell, his wife, grantors of Utah and Salt Lake Counties, Utah, hereby convey and warrant to UTAH POWER & LIGHT COMPANY, a corporation, its successors in interest and assigns, Grantee, for the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable consideration, a perpetual easement and right of way for the erection and continued maintenance, repair, alteration, inspection, re-location, and replacement of the electric transmission, distribution, telephone and telegraph circuits of the grantee, and four towers, with the necessary guys, stubs, cross-arms and other attachments thereon, or affixed thereto, for the support of said circuits, under, upon and across a tract of land fifty (50) feet in width, belonging to the Grantors, in Utah County, Utah, described as follows:

Twenty-five (25) feet on each side of a line:

Commencing at Tower #76 on Olmsted-Springville Power Transmission line, which tower is located at a point approximately 1525 feet south and 1895 feet west of the NE corner of Sec. 17, Township 7 South, Range 3 East, Salt Lake Meridian; thence running S 30°14'E, 1645 feet more or less to east boundary of Grantor's land; all contained in east half of said Section 17

Together with all rights of ingress and egress necessary or convenient for the full and complete use, occupation and enjoyment of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto, including the right to cut and remove timber, trees, brush, over-hanging branches and other obstructions which may injure or interfere with the Grantee's use, occupation or enjoyment of this easement.
