lawful money of the United States of America, to and is paid by the said part of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has been granted, bargained, sold, aliened, remised, released, conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, remise, release, convey and confirm unto the said part of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever that certain piece or parcel of land, situate in the County of Weber and Territory of Utah bounded and described as follows:—

Being the West half of the West half of the North east quarter section thirty three (33) Township sixth North Range two (2) West of the 1st Meridian, reserving however to the grantor his heirs and assigns the use of the following well and spring and running in said land, said use not to be exclusive of any legitimate use of the same by the grantee and also reserving such right of way over such tract as may be necessary for the use thereof.

TOGETHER with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profits thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, and property, possession, claim and demand whatsoever, as well in law as in equity, of the said part of the first part, of, in or to said premises, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises, together with the appurtenances unto the said part of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever.
