## Quit Claim Deed.

G. L. Differbaugh<sup>nd</sup> Mrs. G. L. Differbaugh his wife<sup>nd</sup> Mrs. G. L. Differbaugh in her own right (said Mrs. G. L. Differbaugh being otherwise and more correctly known as Mrs. M. C. Differbaugh) of Eden City Weber County, State of Utah, hereby Quit Claims to Royal J. Whitlock Grantee of Evanston City Cook County, Illinois for the sum of One Dollar<sup>rd</sup> other valuable considerations the following described tracts of land in Box Elder County, State of Utah: one undivided one-fourth ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) interest in <sup>nd</sup> to Sections sixteen (16)<sup>nd</sup> thirty-two (32), Township nine (9) North, Range seven (7) West of the Salt Lake Meridian<sup>nd</sup> Section twenty-six (26), Township nine (9) North Range eight West of said Meridian.

Subject to the condition that unless within ninety days from the date hereof standard oil well drilling machinery be placed in operation within five miles from said land or some part thereof<sup>nd</sup> unless work be continued until a well is sunk to a depth of one thousand feet (unless oil be sooner struck in paying quantities) this deed shall become void<sup>nd</sup> all interest hereby acquired shall revert to the grantors.
