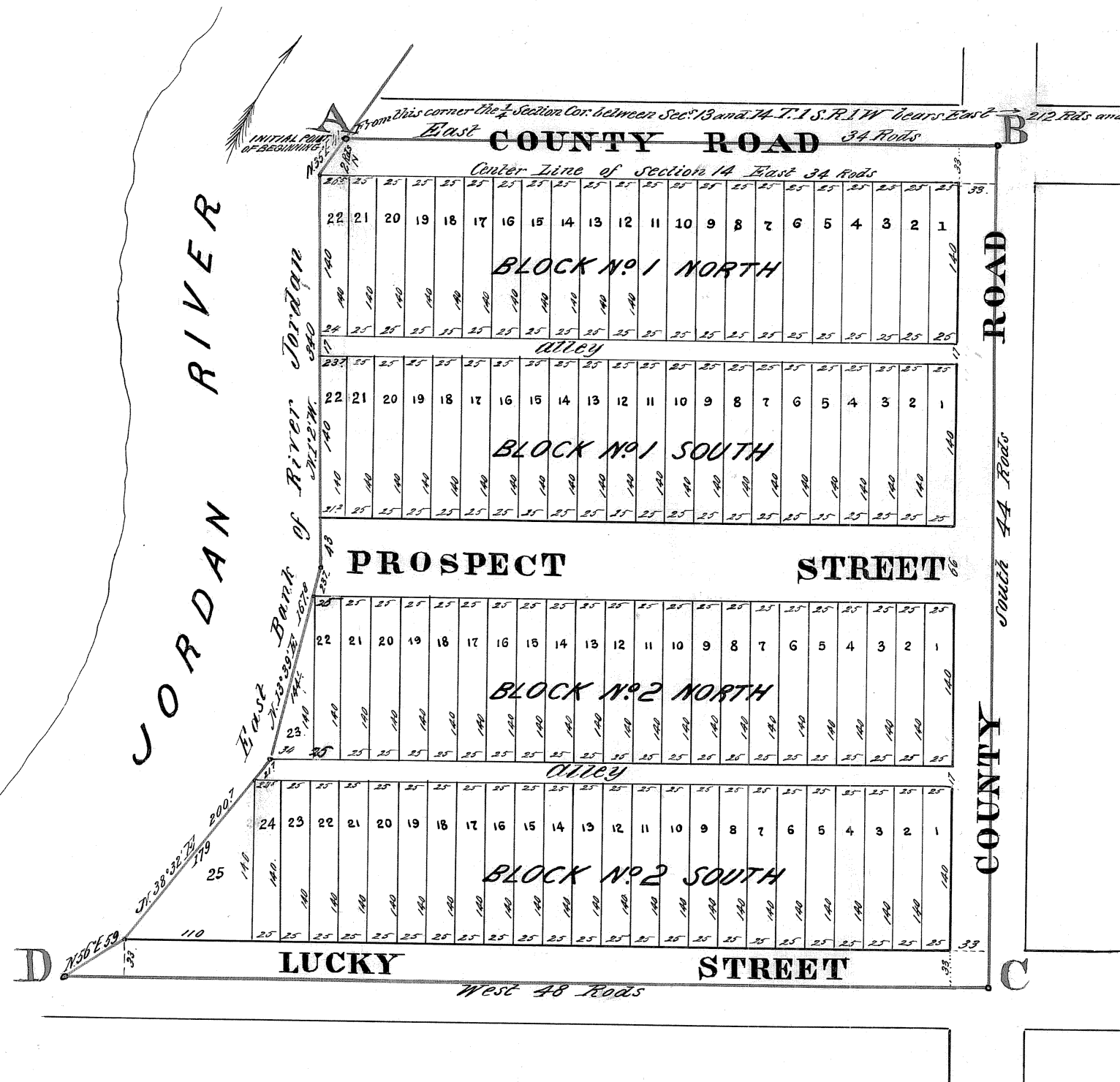
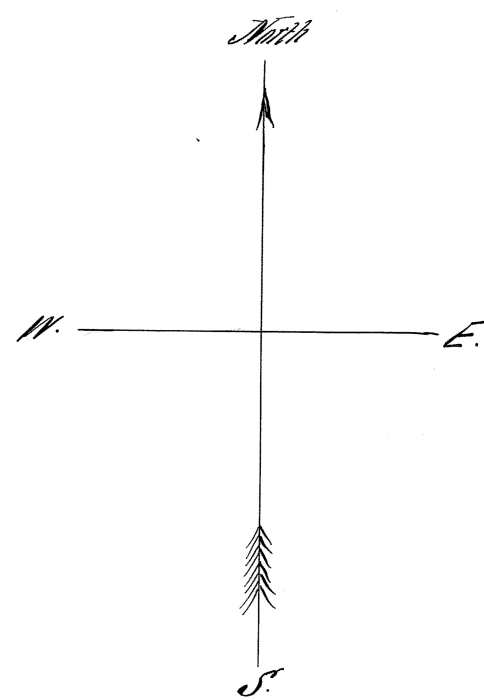


BEYLE'S RIVERSIDE PLOT

SALT LAKE CITY, UTAH.

Subdivision of a part of Lot 5 of Sec. 14 T. 1 S. R. 1 W.
of Salt Lake Mer., Utah.



Note. All Lots in this Plot are 25 X 140 feet except all those bordering on the East Bank of the River Jordan which are marked with dimensions as represented. Streets 66 feet or 4 rods wide, half-streets and county roads 33 feet or 2 rods wide, and Alleys 17 feet wide. The boundaries of the land comprising "Beyle's Riverside Plot" are represented on this diagram by red lines and corners marked "A, B, C, D" and are divided by courses and distances from actual measurements. From corner at point "A" on the East Bank of Jordan River, the U. S. line cor. between sections 13 and 14 in Township 1 South, Range 1 West, Range East 212 rods and South 2 rods, according to the surveys of adjoining grounds and my own examination of the same.

Variation 76° 30' East.

The said Beyle's Riverside Plot, as is represented on this diagram embraces original blocks 33 and 34 of five acres each, as laid out on Riverside Plat on file in the Office of the Recorder of Salt Lake County at Salt Lake City, Utah.

Now all men by these by these presents that we F. Beyle and Kate Beyle his wife are the owners of the tract of land represented on this diagram as the "Beyle's Riverside Plot" acquired by purchase from Arthur J. Beane on the 2nd day of December 1889 and divided by actual survey with magnetic declination at 16° 30' E. as follows to wit: Commencing at point "A" 2 rods North of the intersection of the Center line of section 14 in T. 1 S. R. 1 W. of Salt Lake Meridian with the East Bank of River Jordan thence East 34 rods to the center of a 4 rods county road at point "B"; thence South 44 rods to point "C"; thence West 40 rods to point "D"; thence Northward along the East Bank of Jordan River N. 56° E. 59 feet, thence N. 38° 32' E. 200 7/8 feet, thence N. 73° 39' E. 167 1/2 feet, thence N. 1° 2' W. 340 feet, thence N. 35° E. 41 feet to the place of beginning. All containing 10 acres more or less.

And as such owners the said F. Beyle and Kate Beyle his wife do hereby dedicate forever for the use of the Public, all the streets and alleys as represented on this diagram of the said Beyle's Riverside Plot situated in the part of Lot 5 of Section 14 in T. 1 S. R. 1 W. of Salt Lake Meridian, Salt Lake County, Utah Territory.
