Certificate

chs. 256 — Whereas John H. Restall of Weber County Utah Territory has deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Salt Lake City Utah Territory whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said John H. Restall according to the provisions of the act of Congress of the 24th of April 1870, entitled "An Act making further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the south West quarter of Section twenty, in Township six North, of Range One West in the District of Lands subject to sale at Salt Lake City Utah Territory Containing One hundred and sixty Acres according to the Official Plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the general Land Office by the Surveyor General, which said tract has been purchased by the said John H. Restall.

Now know ye, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the several Acts of Congress in such case made and provided, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said John H. Restall and to his heirs, the said tract above described:

It's have and to hold the same, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, therunto belonging, unto the said John H. Restall and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local customs, laws, and decisions of courts, and also subject to the right of the proprietor of a vein or lode to extract and remove his ore therefrom, should the same be found to penetrate or intersect the premises hereby granted, as provided by law.

In witness whereof, I, Ulysses S. Grant President of the United States of America, have caused these letters to be made Patent, and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.

Given under my hand, at the City of Washington the first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy two and of the Independence of the United States the thirty sixth.
