

This Indenture, made the 2nd day of November A.D. 1850, between James Blanche of Ogden City, Utah, of the first part, and Thomas W. Weston of the same place, of the second part, Witnesseth:
 That said first party, James Blanche, for and in consideration of sum of five dollars, the money contained
 in the aforesaid first part, and in consideration of his heretofore acknowledged, have granted, sold
 allowed, permitted, released, procured conveyed, and by these presents doth give, grant, convey unto the said
 second party, Thomas W. Weston five hundred and six acres of land, situate, lying and being in the
 County of Utah, Territory of Utah, to-wit: Commencing at a point in the south
 chain (120th) West from the North East Corner of the South East Quarter of Section 19, Township
 19 North, Range 10 West, of the Salt Lake Meridian running thence S 84th West (on
 East side of the street) one and 5/8 (1.625) chains, thence East eight (8) and 2/3 (8.333) chains, thence
 West one and 5/8 (1.625) chains, to the quarter section line thence West seven and 2/3 (7.333) chains,
 to the point of beginning containing one (1) acre of land.

I, the said Thomas W. Weston, the grantee, do hereby certify and do hereby certify that the sum of the foregoing
 acres of land, together with all and singular the premises, together with the appurtenances thereto belonging,
 with all rights and claims, including all my right, title, claim, interest, possession, claim, and
 demand whatsoever, as well as, have as my equity of said first part, of, in, or to, said premises, and every
 part and parcel thereof.

I, the said Thomas W. Weston, do hereby certify, together with the appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said second
 party, said five hundred and six acres of land, and said first party, said five hundred and six acres of land, and all
 persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same shall and will Thenceforth and by these
 presents forever Defeat.
