It being a tract of land 16 1/2 feet on each side from the center line of said Canal as now located and operated across said land by said company. The grantors hereby reserve a right of way for a private road and fences across said banks and the right to water stock, but agree to in no way interfere with the free flow of the water, nor injure the Banks of said canal.
