Raybould of the City and County of Salt Lake party of the first part and Charlotte Olive of the City County and Territory aforesaid and Mary Ann Pullin of the City County and Territory aforesaid the parties of the second part, witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand and <sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> dollars currency of the United States of America, to him in hand paid by the said parties of the second part the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged has granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents does grant bargain sell and convey unto the said party of the second part and to their heirs and assigns forever all the following described property, to wit The East half of lot two (2) in Block Fifty (53) containing one hundred (100) rods or plot and on Plot "B" of the Great Salt Lake City Survey, said property is situated lying and being in the City and County of Salt Lake in the Territory of Utah, together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise appertaining and the messuages and messuages, remainder and remainder, rents issues and profits thereof and also all the Estate, right, title, interest property, possession claim and demand whatsoever as well in law as in Equity, of the said party of the first part, of or to the said premises and every part and parcel thereof, <sup>with</sup> the appurtenances to have and to hold all and singular the said premises together with the appurtenances unto the said parties of the second part their heirs and assigns forever.
