TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, Axcil Blonquist, of Coalville, of the County of Summit, State of Utah, heretofore purchased from the State of Utah, the lands hereinafter described, pursuant to the laws of said State in such case made and provided,

AND WHEREAS the said Axcil Blonquist, has paid for said lands, pursuant to the conditions of said sale, and the laws of the State duly enacted in relation thereto, the sum of Five Hundred Ninety-Five and 65/100 (\$595.65) Dollars and all legal interest thereon accrued, as fully appears by the certificate of the proper officer, now on file in the office of the Secretary of State of the State of Utah.

NOW THEREFORE, I Simon Bamberger, Governor, in consideration of the premises and by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the laws of the State of Utah, in such case made and provided, do issue this PATENT, in the name and by the authority of the State of Utah, hereby granting and confirming unto the said Axcil Blonquist, and to his heirs and assigns forever, the following piece or parcel of land, situate in the County of Summit, State aforesaid, to-wit:

The Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$); the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$); the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$); the West Half (W $\frac{1}{2}$) of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) and lot Three (3) of Section Eighteen (18) in Township Two (2) North Range Five (5) East of the Salt Lake Meridian.-

Reserving to the United States, all coal in said lands, and to it, or persons authorized by it, the right to prospect for, mine and remove coal from the same, upon compliance with the conditions and subject to the limitations of the act of Congress, approved June 22nd, 1910 (36 Stat., 583.)

Containing Two Hundred Thirty Eight and 26/100 (238.26) acres according to the said certificate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the above described and granted premises unto the said Axcil Blonquist, and to his heirs and assigns forever, subject to any easement or right of way as may have been established or acquired according to law, over the same or any part thereof and subject also to all rights of way for ditches, tunnels, and telephone and transmission lines that may have been constructed by authority of the United States.
